The Rev. Dr. John Cummins September 8, 1926 – December 11, 2021

Cummins, Rev. Dr. John, age 95 of Minneapolis, died peacefully at home on December 11. Retired minister of First Universalist Church of Minneapolis. A lifelong leader in liberal religion, social justice and nonviolent action. He marched in Selma with Martin Luther King; protested the Vietnam war and counseled young men facing the draft; championed women's rights, one-world government and the sanctuary movement for refugees; mentored women and men entering the liberal ministry.
